Assessment

The SCR Exam is a comprehensive assessment covering climate risk guidelines and methodologies. It includes 90 multiple-choice questions, including case studies, that require both analytical thinking and practical application. Candidates are allotted four hours to complete their Exam. Offered in American English, the Exam is in-person at Pearson VUE test centers worldwide, available in April and October. Scheduling requires a 48-hour minimum, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Certificate

Candidate will only receive the certificate from GARP upon successfully passing thefinal Exam. The minimum passing score is : 60%
